Schools still requiring blocked scheduling will begin performing on the first day of the event and continue until all blocks are completed. Any studio needing blocked scheduling must email info@thatsentertainmentpa.com (Subject Line must state "Studio Block Event Date & Location"). Awards will not be held after blocked sessions. You are welcome to pick up awards during your award ceremonies, at the end of the event or pay for shipping and handling. Please view page 3 & 4 for a tentative schedule of the event.

Special requests can not be honored for Nationals.

Directors email your name, studio name and cell phone number; so a TE representative may keep in contact with you during the event.

Last Chance Regional (LCR) Information

All routines must qualify with a gold score or higher to participate in our Nationals. Routines and/or schools that did not have an opportunity to qualify can take advantage of our Virtual Last Chance Regional. Improve and Parent Routines are not required to qualify. Complete your online entries and payment & have videos uploaded no later than *May 22, 2022*.

2022 National Championship Finals Tentative Schedule

*Be prepared for events, dates and times to be adjusted as necessary.
Must be available for the entire event.*

- Start and end times will be determined by the number of entries
- We can start each day as early as 7:00am, please be prepared and make travel or hotel arrangements accordingly
- *There will be 1 award ceremony at the end of each day with Placement and Adjudicated awards only*
- **Final Awards Ceremony will include all Special & Top Awards last day of the event**
- Anyone participating in the music videos and/or movies must be prepared to arrive a day early and/or stay a day later. More details TBA
- 3 Day events follow a condensed version of the 4-day schedule
- TE may add or subtract days as needed
- *Reminder, we can not honor special requests*

Day 1

- Starting with Block Scheduling (*Awards will not be held after blocked sessions*)
- Followed by Solos & Title Q&A.
- If time allows prior to awards we will move into Duets and Trios,
- If time allows after awards TE Elite Team Practice and/or (1 FREE) 10 & Up Workshop

Day 2

- Starting with remaining Solos (*if any*), Duets & Trios. (*We do our best to complete all Solos Day 1*)
- Followed by Groups and/or Productions
- Free Workshops immediately after awards

Day 3

- Starting with remaining Groups &/or Productions
- Free Workshops immediately after awards
- Nationals TE's Magical World Costume Party & Rep Your Studio Battle
- Top 3 Entertainer of the Year Routines announced during the Party

Day 4

- Concludes with any remaining group before the Final Showcase Rehearsal
- Mandatory Final Production Rehearsal for Closing Award Ceremony
- Closing award Ceremony opens with Top 3 EOTY routines, Parents Dance off, Special Performances & TE's Magical World award ceremony showcase (*Featuring 2021 National Finals Vocal Winner Performances*)

Final awards Ceremonies include but not limited to:

- The Crowning of Mr. & Miss 2022 Title/Scholarship Winners
- Top 5 and/or 10 High Score Winners
- Special Awards which include Showmanship, Judges Choice, Choreography, Sportsmanship and More!
- Concluding with The Entertainer of the Year Cup, Rep Your Studio Award (Team Spirit), Diamond Dance Challenge Award, Vocal Winners, Spark Award & Skyscraper Trophy for Highest Scoring Production and Overall High Scores of the Event!

Each year That's Entertainment hosts FREE Choreography workshops. Judges, Staff and/or Guest instructors choreograph a production that will be performed at the opening of the Final Awards Ceremony. This year's theme is (TE's Magical World). Workshops are closed, only registered participants accepted.

Requirements for participating in workshops and showcase:

- Registration for workshops will be required. Your performers spot is reserved once payment is complete for both Entries & National T-Shirts. "First come first serve". Workshop Registration and T-shirts orders are available on your tour pro registration as attendee add ons.
- Be sure to order Elite Team Shirts for those selected to be on the TE Elite Team and Nationals shirts for the rest of your competitors.
- Elite Team members may participate and perform with age appropriate workshops classes as well as Elite Team Workshop
- Your attendance at the workshop is your commitment to perform in the Final Production Routine
- Mandatory Attendance for Final Production Rehearsal Required

Choreography Workshops will be provided each day:

- TE Elite Team workshop will be 1 1/2-2hrs
- 9 & under Jazz workshop will be 1 ¼hrs
- 10 & Up will have a 1 1/2hrs
- 10 & Up Free Workshop genres may include (Acro, Contemporary, Jazz, Lyrical, Modern, Musical Theatre and/or Tap)
- Introductory special offer Hip Hop Intensive 1 1/2 hrs Level 1 (Beg/Int) & Level 2 (Int/Adv) offered
- Mandatory Showcase Practice 2-3hrs

- Magical/Fantasy Accessories & Make Up

DDC Award & Cash Prize; Winner Takes All!

- Upgrades for each routine entering DDC. Upgraded routines receive live & audio critiques
- Your routines compete in its regular scheduled category and for all additional awards.
- Age, level, routine size and genre will not be separated for the DDC Challenge
- If there are 10 or more routines in both the JR & SR age levels we will separate them by JR (7-12yrs) & SR (13-18yrs)
- Mini (6 & under) age group not accepted in the DDC

Top Vocalist Award Winners *Sponsored by Spark Evolution*

Awarded to the highest scoring JR & SR competitor in the vocal genre at the Shooting and/or All Star Level. Must have 5 or more routines in the (JR) and/or (SR) age group, Shooting & All Star levels to be awarded.

Junior Solo Winners (7-12yrs): Receive a Free Single; produced, written, recorded, mix & mastered by FRMG.

Senior Solo Winners (13-18yrs): Receive a Free Single & Music Video; produced, written, recorded, mix & mastered by FRMG.

TE Elite Team Nominees

- Judges have chosen a **select** group of competitors *in the Shooting & All Star Levels* at each live or virtual regional
- NATIONALS: TE Elite Team- Regionally Nominated Elite Team Competitors that attend Nationals must attend with their school and qualified entries.
- As with any That's Entertainment Event, a studio staff member must attend

Nominated TE Elite Team Competitors may participate in the following:

- TE ELITE TEAM WORKSHOPS
- National Finals Showcase Special TE ELITE TEAM performance segment
- Performance opportunities with vocal winners
- Opportunities to work on and appear in our next Social Issue Music Videos.
- One scene will be filmed during National. Competitors should be willing to travel to the designated locations to participate in the full music video experience

TE Movie Award

- Must be 13 & up and participating in the Acting or Musical Theatre genres for Regionals & Nationals
- Judges will select 1 person from these age divisions and genres at each National for a Leading role in our TE short film series.
- At regionals competitors will be selected for supporting and additional cast roles
- 2022 National Leading role winners and 2023 Regional cast winners will start filming at Nationals & potentially sometime between (Aug-Dec 2023).

Please Note: Our Elite Team & Movie Cast Members are invited to participate & experience what it is like to be on set of a real music video and/of film set. This is a learning opportunity for members to get a glimpse of what it would be like if they choose to continue a career in the entertainment industry. Videos will take time and not be released until editor's approval. All members must bring their "A Game" during filming so that editors can do their best to feature everyone. Editors must create the best product possible to be released.

Rep Your Studio: "Team Spirit Award"

- Wear team shirts, hats, pants, jackets, etc; and create team signs to show your studio pride throughout the entire event.
- Parents and visitors can also be involved in supporting their studio of choice.

Note: Judges and staff will be judging throughout the entire event. Make your studios proud. The studio with the Most Team Spirit will win.

(ADCC) Studio of Excellence Award Winners

Presented to a studio that exemplifies the mission and purpose of The ADCC, uniting to promote Quality, Integrity and Opportunity within the Dance Competition industry.
Studio will receive a banner & a featured ad with the ADCC.

Nominated routines that perform at our National Finals will compete for our Spark award & chance to promote your Social Awareness Issue on TE & Spark Websites.

Entertainer of the Year Cup

Who Will Bring It Home, Will It be You?

Entertainer of The Year Nominees (EOTY)

This prestigious cup is awarded to 1 routine per Nationals based solely on entertainment value

- Once you register & pay; your EOTY Nominated routine will be automatically considered for the EOTY Cup
- Routine size may change from regionals to nationals, must still be a group routine.
- Nominees will compete in their regularly scheduled category
- Judges will select Top 3 EOTY routines, which will be announced prior to the Final Award Ceremony Showcase
- Top 3 will perform again prior to the showcase

EOTY Winners Receive:

- The EOTY Title, Cup & Bragging rights, but that's not all
- Winner receives a Free routine at next seasons Nationals for the chance to keep your EOTY Title
- Choreographer of the winning routine will have the opportunity to teach & appear in the next Music Video at next seasons Nationals
- Choreographer & studio name recognition will appear in the music video credits

Title/Scholarship

Titles:

- For Mr. or Miss TE there must be 3 or more competitors in each age division for a Title to be awarded separately (Mini 6 & Under, JR 7-9, 10-12, SR 13-15, 16-18)
- If there are less than 3 in any age division (ex. JR and/or SR) titles will be combined
- Composite scores from your title routines and Q & A will be used to determine the title winner, highest score wins
- Q&A will be asked day 1 prior to awards
- Dressy Casual required during Q & A
- Title contestants 13 & up will be required to help raise Scholarship money with a scheduled time to go around with raffle tickets during the event

Scholarships:

- One Senior (13-18yrs) at each National with a minimum of 5 or more contenders will be awarded a scholarship.
- Scholarship awards will be made out to the attending school.

TE's Magical World Costume Party!
All Studios/Competitors & Families are Welcome!

- Dress up as your favorite magical/fantasy character
- Giveaways, Drinks & Snacks provided
- Prizes given to the individual with the best costume
- Prizes given to the school with the best group costume

“Rep your Studio Battle”

Will take place During the Party

- Studios choose a select number of students to represent them in the dance battle
- Competitors should dress up as your favorite magical/fantasy character. Team costumes are encouraged but not required.
- *Music for Round 1 chosen by the school, must be uploaded to your account 3 weeks prior to the event and provided on your back up flash drive.
- Rounds 2 & 3 are DJ's Choice.
- Judges will select who advances to each round
- Battle will consist of all styles of dance, choreography & free style included
- Round 1: 1 1/2 minute choreographed routine. *Music must follow the Theme of the party (Magical/Mystical/Fantasy).* Top routines advance to round 2
- Round 2: 1 -minute freestyle
- Round 3: Top 2 battle it out for the trophy. (Choreography & Free Style Accepted)
- Winner will be announced and presented with the “Rep your Studio: Battle Award”
